

## New Students List of Needed Items

The following is a list of items you will need as a dorm student. These things may be purchased at the college, but it will save you extra money if you bring them from home.

King James Bible

Dictionary

Writing Paper

Pens, pencils

3-ring notebook & college notebook paper

Pillow and 2 pillow cases

2 sets of sheets (single/bunk size for single students or double bed for married students)

Towels and wash cloths

Light blanket

Toiletries (soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, shaving supplies, etc.)

Flash light

Lightweight jacket or sweater (buildings & classrooms are air conditioned)

Shower clogs

Hairdryer

Work clothing:\*\*

Hard soled shoes for men; tennis shoes (sneakers) for ladies

T-Shirt and Blue jeans or work pants for men (No contemporary or unchristian art work on clothing)

Dress clothing:\*\*

Men: Dress shirt, suit or suit jacket, tie for church services

Ladies: church-type dresses, blouse, skirt

(formal dresses may be worn for banquets and special occasions, but are not required)

Casual clothing all for classes:\*\*

Men: shirt and tie with casual type trousers for all classes (no blue jeans). Dress shoes only.

Ladies: dresses, jumpers, skirts and blouses or sweaters; dress shoes or conservative sandals.

**\*\*Dress code must be adhered to for all activities:**

**Women Students** are expected to dress neatly and modestly at all times. This means that clothing for ladies should meet at least four criteria: high enough, thick enough, long enough and loose enough. Dresses, skirts and culottes are to be to the middle of the knee and must be modest from a standpoint of exposure and accent. Jean skirts and jumpers are only permitted after the evening meal on weekdays, all day on Saturday and on specified outings.

**Men Students**--dress shirts are to be designed to be worn with a tie, and the shirt should button at the neck. Blue jeans may be worn only after the evening meal on weekdays, all day Saturdays, and on specified outings. Necklace, bracelets and earrings are not appropriate men's attire on or off-campus. Hats and caps must be removed when entering any building.

Irons & ironing boards are not provided. Students may purchase and share these items in their dorm.

**All prescribed medications** must be checked with the Administration.
